What happens next?

We will respond to your complaint within 5 working days informing you who is dealing with it and how long it is likely to take.

We aim to respond to complaints within 14 working days. However, some complaints take longer to investigate and when they do, we will contact you to advise you when you can expect a response from us.

All comments and complaints will be recorded by Bike for Good and used to help us improve our services.

What if I'm unhappy with the response?

If you have made a complaint and are unhappy with the response you receive, you can write to the Chief Executive, who will look at the situation and decide if further action is needed. If you are still unhappy, you can write to the Chair of Bike for Good, who will look at the situation again and decide if any further action is needed.

You can contact the Chief Executive and Chair at the details above. Emails should include in the subject line FAO the CEO / the Chair as appropriate.
